



Field Trip Requirements & Rules

Requirements

- Belong to an educational organization in grades Pre-K-12
- Visit us Monday - Friday, 9 am - 5 pm
- Have a minimum of 5 students
- Chaperones must be 21 years or older
- Make reservations in advance

Payment

Payment arrangements must be made in advance and is due upon arrival to the Museum. Field Trip rates are fully discounted. No coupons or membership discounts apply.

Tours

- *Teachers are always free!*
- \$6.00 per student, plus tax
- Adult chaperones \$13.00 each, plus tax
- Any support person accompanying a student with a disability admitted free

Learning Labs

\$5.00 per student per lab which may be added to any tour to provide an educational and fun filled visit.

Museum Guidelines and Etiquette

We ask all visitors, teachers, and patrons to read over our guidelines and adhere to them during your visit.

Please advise students to refrain from:

- Loud or inappropriate language
- Running, skipping, or jumping while in the Museum
- Pushing, shoving, or aggressive behavior
- Disruptive behavior to other visitors
- Do not touch any of the airplanes or exhibits

- Be respectful to Museum staff, volunteers, and docents
- We ask that students do not drop objects over the balconies and second floor overlooks as it may cause injury to those below

Museum Gift Bags

If you are in a time crunch, the Museum Gift Shop offers teachers the option of pre-ordering Museum Gift Bags for students at a nominal charge of \$15 each. The bags contain several specially selected items from the store such as: military dog tags, spinning propellers, stickers, and bookmarks (contents subject to availability of merchandise). The gift bags will be ready for you to take at the conclusion of your visit.

Parking and Accessibility
